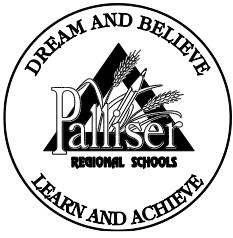
Students will be eating lunch during period 4 from 11:45-12pm. They need to bring a lunch that is quick to eat (no heating up required).

ELEMENTS OF RISK

If you choose to participate in the field trip to Telus Spark on May 30/18, you must understand that you bear the responsibility for any injury that may occur.

The Board of Trustees of Palliser Regional Schools has invested in IAP Student Accident Insurance, with enhanced coverage for the school year. This provides insurance coverage for all students, teachers

and non-teachers on Palliser staff from the time they leave their residence to travel to school to the time they arrive at their residence (or their first destination) after school. This coverage also applies during approved and supervised school trips/activities.
