

Student Supply List—Grade 9

The following is a list of what each student needs to bring to class on the first day of school. Please be sure that your child's name is on all supplies & uniform pieces.

GENERAL

- 3" Binder with subject dividers
- 3 Plastic duotangs-3 prong (for Social Studies & LA)
- Loose-leaf paper (400 sheets)
- Graph paper
- Pencil crayons
- Pens, pencils & erasers (In a storage container to be kept in locker for use as needed. Quantity is dependent upon the responsibility of the user)
- Coloured marking pens (2 colours of choice—these will be used extensively)
- Highlighters
- Reinforcements
- Metric Ruler
- 2 Boxes of Kleenex (to be given to homeroom teacher on the 1st day)
- Geometry set
- Scientific calculator (TI-30 or similar)
- NIV Bible to be used at school as a textbook
- 1 Chromebook sleeve or case (11.6" laptop case)
- 1 Travel/small mouse for Chromebook use. **(OPTIONAL)**
- Reusable water bottle
- 1 School Lock **purchased from homeroom teacher** in September for \$5.00 (if you already have an HCA lock from a previous year, you are not required to purchase a new one). Students will keep this lock from year to year. If lost, they will be required to purchase a new one from the school.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE

Phys Ed

- REQUIRED:** 1 Heritage black school gym strip. (Available to purchase from the gym teacher in September. The old style yellow, white or grey shirts are no longer acceptable.) If you already have black HCA gym strip from a previous year you are not required to purchase a new one.
- Athletic shoes are a must; leisure shoes and skateboarding shoes are unacceptable. It is best to buy a good pair of cross trainers with non-marking soles.**
