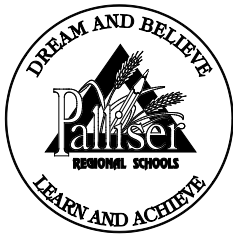
We will leave the school at 9:00 am, tour from 9:30 – 10:45 am, then return to the school 11:15 am.
