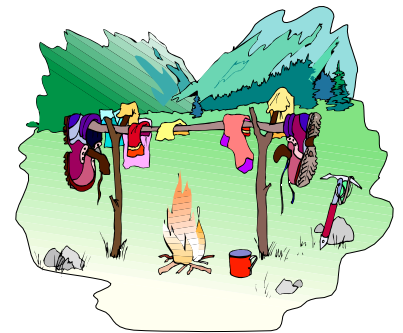

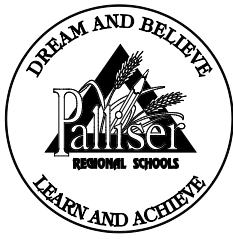

ELEMENTS OF RISK
