Dear Kindergarten to Grade 8 Parents,

This year we're taking a new approach to the traditional conference and switching to Parent teacher conferences BEFORE report cards go home. This pro-active approach allows teachers, parents and students to focus on student learning by allowing us to address student strengths and areas of improvement without the distraction of a final grade. Students will then have the opportunity to address any areas of concern prior to receiving their final term report card.

If you have a child on an IPP it is **IMPERATIVE** that you meet with your child's IPP coordinating teacher (typically the homeroom teacher). You will discuss your child's IPP for the year by **reviewing the goals and accommodations** designed to support your child's academic success.

The event code is **5p9au**



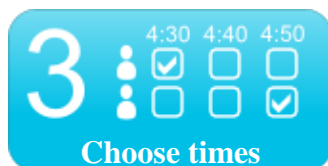
Next it's as easy as 1 – 2 – 3...
